Damage From an Accident

Incidents such as your fence being hit by a falling tree or by a vehicle typically cause significant damage to the quality, structure, and stability of your wood.

Broken or Missing Boards

Broken or missing boards compromise your fence's level of safety and structural integrity, making it a safety hazard until it is replaced.

Holes In the Wood

Holes in your wood fence are most likely caused by insects, wildlife, or microorganisms, and usually means there is extensive damage under the surface 4

Splintering

Cracks and splits in your wood indicate that it is deteriorating and weak, making it vulnerable to storms or harsh weather conditions.

Staining

Yellow or grey stains on your fence are tell-tale signs that the wood has started rotting or molding. 6

Leaning Fences

Leaning is usually caused by the weakening of fence posts, which increases your chance of developing warped or broken fence boards.
