Include a fridge for drinks and condiments



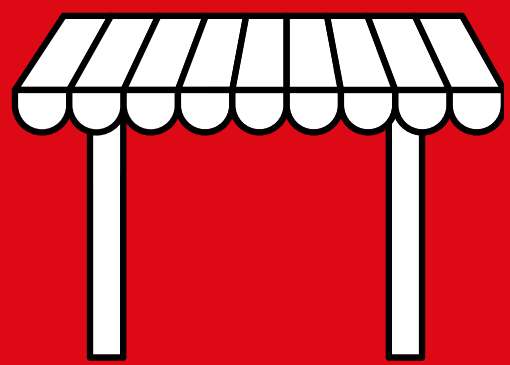
A sink and counter space makes food prep easy

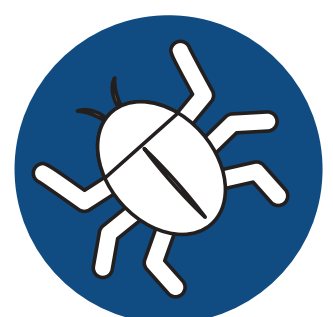
## CREATE AN AMBIANCE
